* The MSS of articles by these three outstanding Scots of their day were in the possession of the Director of this archive who has recorded them on tape for inclusion in the archive. They were written for a promotional book to attract new industries to Scotland (The Scottish Information Office, the Central Office of Information in London and the Scottish Council (Development and Industry) were involved in the production which was 'fathered' by the Council).

The material was distributed in all parts of the world by the Government's information services but the production was never made publicly available in Scotland. Hence the decision by the Director of Scotland's Record to make these three items available to scholars and research workers in the National Library of Scotland.
