Personal and some earlier family correspondence and papers (from ca. 1738), and the Iona Community papers, of the Very Revd. Dr. George Fielden MacLeod (b. 1895); 4th Bart. (1944) and Baron MacLeod of Fuinary (cr. 1967); Minister of St. Cuthbert's (1926-30) and of Govan Old (1930-8); Founder and Leader (1938-67) of the Iona Community; Moderator of the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland (1957-8); and Rector of Glasgow University (1968-71). The files are arranged in a continuous numerical sequence. *Wherever possible files relating directly to the work of Lord MacLeod (henceforth referred to as GFM) for the Iona Community are placed in the Community sections of this list.*

The papers have been used by Ronald Ferguson for his biography of GFM, George MacLeod, Founder of the Iona Community, London, 1990.
